

High Inclusion of Distillers Dried Grains with Solubles (DDGS) in Swine Diets: Limitations and Opportunities in Pork Production.

Swine producers continue to cautiously investigate the use of corn distillers dried grains with solubles (DDGS). The utilization of DDGS in diet formulation has continued to increase, but concerns of product variability, antinutritional factors, losses in feed efficiency, losses in carcass weight and carcass fat quality continue to limit the utilization of this ethanol by product. Field evaluations and research to maximize DDGS inclusion will continue as the volatility of commodity markets continues to increase for swine producers.
